The main field of my research concerns morality of the modern diplomacy. Looking at both, the past and present, I try to show that diplomacy can be moral.

One the academic level, it is hard to find any discussion about the morality of diplomacy and even more rarely diplomacy itself is termed “moral”. And this lack of discussion and scientific reflection inspired me to focus my research on this area.

I work as a lecturer of Political Theology, Diplomatic and Consular Law, Diplomatic Protocol and Etiquette at two Universities: Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań and The College of Social and Media Culture in Toruń.
